Avi Werjuka who farms at Latheronwheel, Caithness in the Scottish Highlands started in free range egg production in January of this year. After several years of planning he chose a building from James Killen Ltd. He has chosen to construct two timber sheds to house a 32,000 bird operation.

The unit is now the UK's most northerly 32,000 bird free range farm, being only 30 miles from John O' Groats.
